Description of Activities


Interpretation, translation, Japanese-language learning support, tour guides, assistants for various events, etc. There is a wide range of activities.

■ Registration and Use

(Q1) Can anybody register for and take part in the CIVoB program?

(A1) Yes, anybody can register and take part in the CIVoB program, except those who intend to use it for commercial, religious, or political activities.

[Q2] How much does it cost to register for and participate in the CIVoB program?

(A2) No charge is required. Activities should be performed free of charge. However, users (those who want to use the CIVoB) are responsible for transportation, entrance fees, and other costs associated with the activity.

[Q3] When does my registration expire?

[A3] In three fiscal years, including the year you registered.

[Q4] Can I renew my registration after it expires?

[A4] Yes, you can. We will ask you whether you wish to renew your registration at least one month before the date of expiry. So, please check and confirm the contents of the notice.

[Q5] Is it possible to change or correct my personal information after registering?

[A5] Yes. Please send us an e-mail or give us a call to let us know the updated information. You can also make a correction in person at the counter.

■Volunteer Activities

[Q6] What if troubles arise during the volunteer activity?

(Q6) In principle, the parties should aim to resolve their issues through negotiation with one another. On the other hand, please do not hesitate to contact us if you need our help.

In addition, insurance for volunteers is available to cover injuries and liability for damages caused by any mishaps during volunteer activities. For details, please contact the Chiyoda Volunteer Center (Chiyoda Social Welfare Council).

[Q7] Do volunteer activities always have to be done in Chiyoda City?

[A7] In principle, activities shall take place in Chiyoda City. If you wish to conduct activities outside the district, please consult with us.

[Q9] What do I need to do after finishing the volunteer activity?

[A9] Please kindly make a report online or submit the Report Form at our counter, or send it by e-mail, fax, or post to the Chiyoda City Office within 10 days of the date of activity.
