Interpreters, Translators, Assistants in Japanese language, (tour) Guides, Helpers in various events, etc... There is a wide range of the activities.


(Examples of the activities that has been done;)

- You are unable to use The CIVoB for any commercial activities aimed at profitmaking, religious proselytization or political activities.
- There is no remuneration although you may be reimbursed for transportation expenses.

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■About Registration and Use

[Q1] Can anybody register for The CIVoB? Can anybody receive the service?

[A1] Yes, anybody can register and use the CIVoB file, except those who have a purpose of commercial activities aimed at profit-making, specific religious proselytization and/or political activities.

[Q2] What is the procedure following my registration?

[A2] Please come to our counter and submit the *Application for Registration of CIVoB* (including a quick interview for 15minutes)

How to submit	You can fill in the <i>Application for Registration of CIVoB</i> at our counter or try to down load from your computer and bring it to our counter.
Office hour	Monday through Friday from 8:30a.m. to 5:00p.m(Reserved basis)

[Q3] What is the procedure following my application?

[A3] ①Please submit the Application for CIVoB Service.

(Q4) How much is the registration fee? How much does it cost for the usage of CIVoB file?

[A4] No charge is required. As this is a volunteer service, no usage fee is required. However, you need to pay for you and your volunteers' expenses such as transportation, material costs, etc, incurred during the activity.

[Q5] Does submitting an application automatically ensure us plenty of volunteer activities?

[A5] It depends on how many people apply for the usage of The CIVoB file. Our receipt of your application does not give any guarantee of plenty of activities constantly. In addition to The CIVoB, you can be informed about volunteer activities at the Volunteer Center.

[Q6] When does my registration expire?

[A6] In three (3) fiscal years, including the year you registered.

[Q7] After expired, can I update?

(A7) Yes, you can, We will send you a letter about a month before the date of expiry. What you need to do is just to fill in the Reply Sheet and send it back to us.

[Q8] Is it possible to change or correct information after the registration?

(A8) Yes. The easiest way is to give us a call first. Then, we will confirm your information and send you a correction sheet. Please fill in the correction sheet using red ink and send it back to us.

■ About Volunteer Activities

(Q9) What if troubles happen during the volunteer activity?

[Q9] In principle, the parties have to aim to resolve their issues through negotiation with one another. On the other hand, please do not hesitate to contact us when you need our help. Besides, the Event Insurance is available, It will be a promise of reimbursement in the case of loss, damages and/or injuries under the events.

[Q10] Do volunteer activities always have to be done in Chiyoda Ward?

(A10) In principle, we deal with the activities in Chiyoda Ward. If you wish for the volunteer activity outside the chiyoda ward, please consult with us.

[Q11] After the volunteer activity, do I need to submit any kinds of paper such as a report or a questionnaire?

- **(A11)** ① Volunteers: Please kindly fill out the *Activity Report* and turn it in within 10 days from the activity date.
 - ② Users: Please kindly fill out the *Use Report* and turn it in within 10 days from the activity date.
 - **Submission: by one of the following ways; mailing, e-mail, fax, going to the office in person.
