Early Warning/Advisory

(Disaster Prevention Email Service)

Disaster Prevention Emails will be sent out whenever following warnings are issued. With your personal computer, smartphone and cellular phone, you can receive Early Warning/Advisory and Safety Information which is helpful.

- Information to improve your safety;
 - Eyewitness report on a suspicious person, etc. to improve security for your children
 - Fraud damage report
 - Information regarding catastrophic incidents, massive fire, etc.
- Earthquake Early Warning
- Weather Warning/Advisory
- Flood Warning/Advisory for Designated Rivers, such as Arakawa River and Kandagawa River
- Landslide Alert
- Hazardous Wind Watch
- Storm Surge flooding
- Other Weather Information
- Emergency Announcements;
 - Evacuation, Civil Protection, i.e. terror attacks, aerial assaults, missile attacks, etc.
 - Others
- Localized Heavy Rain Information
- Rainband
- Heat Illness Risk Information

Both subscription and use of service are free

(Users shall prepare the electric devices such as smartphones necessary for registration and use your own expense, browsing the website and sending/receiving emails, as communication charges)

- check your computer usage setting in order to receive emails with URLs



Please read the Terms of Service. If you agree to all of the terms and contents, click the "I agree." button.



