


### Autumn

### Parks;

Togo Gensui Memorial Park

Location/Sanbancho 18 Chiyoda-ku, Tokyo

Opened on July 1, 1929. In this area, there used to be the residence of Admiral Heihachiro Togo, Commander-in-Chief of the Combined Fleet. The brick building in the park is the emergency water supply facility for disaster countermeasures. 1500m<sup>3</sup> of fresh water is stored and will be supplied to residents in the event of an emergency.

[Area] 7,199 m (partly under repair work till March 2023)

#### Sotobori Park

Location/Fujimi 2 chome (and Kudan-kita 4 chome),

[Facilities] Baseball ground (not available due to repair work), Sports ground and Children's play park, Tennis courts (sometime in January, not available due to repair work. Please check information at the park office in the Kudan Lifelong Learning Hall TEL 03-3234-2841),

[Area] 38,794.92 m

# Chiyoda City Disaster Prevention

Japan is a country where earthquakes often strike. In fact, close to 20 percent of all major earthquakes in the world have occurred in and around Japan. The 2011 Great East Japan Earthquake, the 2016 Kumamoto Earthquakes and the 2018 Hokkaido Eastern Iburi Earthquakes were all recorded at seismic intensity 7 and resulted in tremendous damage in their respective regions. Earthquakes can occur anywhere in the country and any locations by the ocean are at risk of Tsunami (tidal waves). It is always important to know how to protect yourselves when an earthquake strikes and to be prepared.

#### Information Local disaster prevention measures

Make notes of designated evacuation centers. When the buildings are in danger of collapsing due to an earthquake or submergence by flooding, you must immediately leave your home and evacuate to a safe location. Chiyoda City designate local schools and public facilities to be used as evacuation centers in the event of a disaster. Be sure to know where your nearest evacuation center is. Take time to walk the actual route during disaster training sessions. Avoid evacuating by car.

Actively interact and get to know your neighbors. Building relationship that allow you to freely talk about things that worry you will help build "local disaster prevention capability".

Some companies are also producing bread packed in germ-proof packaging that can be stored for up to one year, therefore, they can be used as emergency provisions. Some snack foods available at convenience stores can be also used as emergency foods. Most people living in disaster-prone areas will keep non-perishable foods and bottled water.

# Bits of Knowledge

The building of Chiyoda City Hall is maintained in consideration of the global environment. It has an automatic light control system that adjust the lighting by the brightness of natural outside light and of solar power generation. We also have equipment to use rainwater and reuse drainage. In the Citizen Gallery, we use LEDs to reduce power consumption to 1/7.
